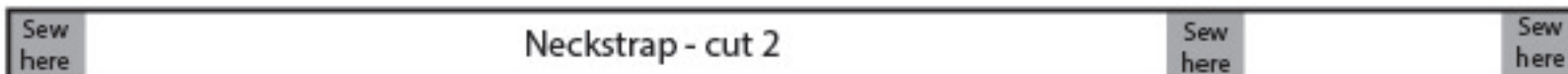


Make a 'RUNNING MARTINGALE' for your Crafty Pony!

Most show jumpers use a 'running martingale' when riding their horses. You can make a 'running martingale' for your Crafty Pony!



You will need:

1. Fabric - leatherette 6cm x 30cm
OR two pieces of thin cotton 6cm x 30cm and Bondaweb or similar adhesive sheet 6cm x 30cm
2. Two metal or plastic rings approx. 1.5cm - 2cm diameter
3. Scissors, needle and matching thread/sewing machine
4. If bonding cotton fabric you will also need an iron and a damp cloth and paper or cloth to protect work surface
5. Tracing paper or ruler and pencil
6. Adult supervision and guidance

If using fabric, bond the two pieces together using the Bondaweb or similar fabric adhesive sheet, please see instructions on how to use adhesive sheet on the Crafty Ponies website www.craftyponies.co.uk



Trace or draw the pattern pieces above onto the cotton fabric or leatherette



Cut out the pattern pieces



Fold the end of the martingale over and sew, matching the grey areas on the pattern
